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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Technical Debt – the cost of reworking a solution caused by choosing an easier or otherwise limited solution. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Example: HL7 – Healthcare’s glue.</li> <li>○ Interface engine example – collecting or attacking HL7</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Cybersecurity plus small business <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Healthcare data is 7x more valuable than financial data on the dark web.</li> <li>○ 43% of all cyber-attacks target small business.</li> <li>○ Compliance does not mean security.</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Cybersecurity is a process not a destination.</li> <li>• KNOWB4 training – good security gateway and education.</li> <li>• Concept of Dual Use</li> <li>• TOR for good.</li> <li>• Encryption – must have but Ransomware is encrypting your data.</li> <li>• Cybersecurity Awareness Training.</li> </ul>
